1 John 2:18-27

“Antichrist”

Definition: “In Place of” “Instead of” or “against”
Christ

1. A person who is called Antichrist (Rev 13, 16, 19)
2. Spirit of Antichrist
3. The Antichrists - False teachers

Characteristics of the Antichrists

1. Left the fellowship of believers (vs 19)
2. Denied that Jesus was the Christ (vs 20-25)
3. Led others astray (vs 26)

My response

1. Know the truth (vs. 21)
2. Walk in the Spirit (vs 26-27)
3. Choose your teachers wisely

Going Deeper

We encourage you to get into God's word this week. Below is a daily reading plan to help you read the Bible each day and learn more about today's message. This short investment of time will pay off huge dividends in your knowledge of God's Word and your relationship with God. Below each reading is a question or two to reflect on throughout your day. If you are journaling you can write down your response and whatever else you got out of it (e.g. what the Holy Spirit is telling you).

Day 1: 1 John 2:18-27

- This is the text from Sunday's sermon. What do you remember about the antichrists? How well do you know the truth (God's Word)? Do you think you can be deceived by false teaching?

Day 2: John 1:1-18

- “Word” refers to “Jesus” so replace Jesus name instead of Word as you read. What do you learn?? What stands out to you?

Day 3: John 14:5-15

- Do you believe Jesus is God? Can you relate to Philip here? Why or why not? What will change today after reading this?

Day 4: John 10:22-33

- How do you feel knowing no one can snatch you out of God's hand? What would've been your response had you been there?

Day 5: Mark 15:33-41

- Consider each person's reactions to the cross. What do you learn from each? What can you relate to?

Day 6: 2 Thessalonians 2:3-12

- Paul writes here about the Antichrist and his ultimate end. What do you learn? To what degree do you “delight in wickedness” rather than the truth?

Day 7: Mark 1:9-15

- Have you made a decision about Jesus? Have you repented and received Jesus? If not, why not now? Confess your sin to God and your desire to turn away from it and follow God. Ask him to forgive you and give you eternal life. (if you make this decision, please let some know at East Hills)

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
